Yes, in 1987 I was a child in Kenya who went to kindergarten in an SOS Children's Village in Mombasa. At this time, the school was the only place with running water and sanitary facilities.

From home I only knew the village well and a rain barrel in which we collected water. Diarrhoeal diseases caused by polluted water were also widespread in my village.

Imagine:

In 2022

1. 16,000 people still die worldwide every week because they do not have access to clean water ... 43% of them are children under 5 years of age.
2. 442 million school days are lost due to absence from illness!

On June 12, I will take part in the Alpen Challenge Lenzerheide over the Albula, Maloja and Splügen (191 km, 4,500 m ascent) - on my Roadbike, with pure muscle power.

I will set an example, suffer for children and provide them with clean water, sanitary facilities and hygiene.

FOR THIS I NEED YOUR HELP!

At the primary school Inhaca Nkalane – Bairro Ribzwene in the Kanyaka district, 491 children are registered - with an uncertain future. The school threatens to collapse.

There are only two latrines for the entire student body, which are in a desolate state. The floor slabs threaten to collapse there is no running water. Absolutely unreasonable.

In addition, a strong storm in December 2020 affected the roof structures of the two school buildings. Since then, temporary devices have been used to protect the two roofs from strong winds and invading rain. Without renovation, they threaten to collapse.

Access to education, clean drinking water and decent sanitation facilities - these living conditions are part of everyday life for the vast majority of children in Switzerland. For children at Inhaca Nkalane Primary School, this is luxury. With the WASH project, we are creating the prospect of a life without fear and poverty for 700 children.
